

Before joining the European Parliament, Prof Jones had served as a full professor of Feminist Legal Studies at Bristol Law School, University of West England, UK. Prof Jones has been researching and teaching law for over 20 years, first at Cardiff Law School and then at Bristol Law School, UWE. Her main teaching and research interests lie in the areas of gender, migration, asylum process, human trafficking, violence against women, all within a human rights perspective. She has volunteered with many NGOs focusing on women's issues, including the European Women Lawyers Association, Wales Assembly of Women, Welsh Women's, European Gender Budgeting Network, Welsh Institute of International Affairs, and Fawcett Society.
