The MEP to Campus programme arranged for former MEP Malcolm Harbour to deliver an online public lecture and student workshop at Pécs University, Hungary. The chosen theme was Parliament's work for Europe's consumers. The event was organised by Dr. Melinda Szappanyos at the Department of Political Science and International Studies and held on September 29th, 2021.

The former Chairman of the Internal Market and Consumer Protection Committee (IMCO) highlighted Parliament's influence on measures that benefitted consumers. These included enhanced rights in electronic communications, mobile phone roaming, passenger travel, product safety and food labelling. He also noted the continued activism by IMCO, and its demands for more consumer-friendly measures in the Digital Markets Act.

The lecture was broadcast on the University Facebook page and promoted with a poster campaign. Dr. Szappanyos was delighted with the lively participation by her students. She and Mr Harbour have agreed to start planning another event in 2022.
